During March, April and May 2008, singer/songwriter Keith James, together with Rick Foot on Double Bass perform their tenth UK tour entitled THE SONGS OF NICK DRAKE in which the almost the entire concert is dedicated to the work of the most loved of all English singer/songwriters.

Previous tours across the country, totalling over 300 concerts, have seen audiences filling arts centres and theatres to hear this music.

Nick Drake himself, was, during his prolific period, somewhat of a mystery. He only lived to record 3 albums, “Five Leaves Left”, “Bryter Later” and “Pink Moon”, all of which were regarded at the time as being flimsy and without the substance that was called for to engage popular audiences. It has only been in the last 10 years that many thousands of listeners have come to appreciate their beauty.

Nick Drake has now, thankfully, become the most revered of all figures to take their place in the world of contemporary acoustic music. It is with this in mind that these concerts are presented.

The overwhelming acclaim of these concerts reached such proportions that Keith and Rick performed Nick Drake’s Music at Glastonbury Festival 2007.
